Privacy Policy Statement
(implemented Jul. 1, 1999)

Purpose:

There is little or no purpose to collecting any personal information from the customers or users of this Website for **La Habra Heights Cafe** (aka "**LHH Cafe**"). If any information is unintentionally obtained, such as through customer testimonials or photographic records, it is purely in the interest of promoting the business of **LHH Cafe** or to encourage the interchange of information about our activities and functions in Arizona and, in particular, past and future jobs and projects. Any information collected may be posted on our Web site for the above purposes but is never sold or given to any other individual or entity.

Information and Cookies:

LHH Cafe may collect and receive the URL you came from, the pages of LHH Cafe's Web site that were viewed during a visit, the date and time and the contents of any forms e-mailed to us. Some of LHH Cafe's Web pages may also make use of "cookie" technology to measure site activity, determine how you arrived at our site and maintain your identity as you navigate through the Web site. A cookie is an element of data that a Web site can send to your browser, which may then store the cookie on your hard drive. Cookies make visiting a Web site easier for you by saving your preferences while you are at the site. The use of cookies is an industry standard and you will find them at many Web sites. LHH Cafe may use the information from cookies to provide services customized to your needs.

Policy:

It is our policy that no person's personal information will be posted on our Web site without consent and that a person may revoke their consent by notifying the Webmaster. It is assumed that if a person "signs" our guest book or submits a testimonial or photograph, consent is inherent in that action.

Children's Information:

We will not knowingly post any personal information for children under the age of 13. All children should have their parent's permission before providing any personal information to our Web site, or to any Web site for that matter. The parent may revoke their consent at any time by following the directions on that same form or by contacting the Webmaster.
